## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

### INSTALLING MIRROR ON WALL (CLOSE TO WALL)

See Figure 1

1. Attach offset bracket to wall or post.
2. Attach mirror to offset bracket and adjust angle.
3. Tighten screws on ball bracket to fix mirror in desired position.
4. You may discard the metal channel and base plate.



### INSTALLING MIRROR ON COUNTER OR CEILING

See Figure 2

1. Attach base plate to either counter or ceiling.
2. Attach metal channel to base plate (use nuts, bolts and washers).
3. Attach offset bracket to other end of channel (use nuts, bolts and washers).
4. Attach mirror to offset bracket.
5. Tighten screws on ball bracket to fix mirror in desired position.

### INSTALLING MIRROR ON WALL

See Figure 3

1. Attach base plate to wall.
2. Cut end of metal channel; bend to right angle.
3. Attach metal channel to base plate (use nuts, bolts and washers).
4. Attach mirror directly to metal channel – you may discard offset bracket.
5. Tighten screws on ball bracket to fix mirror in desired position.



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
