WARNING INFORMATION

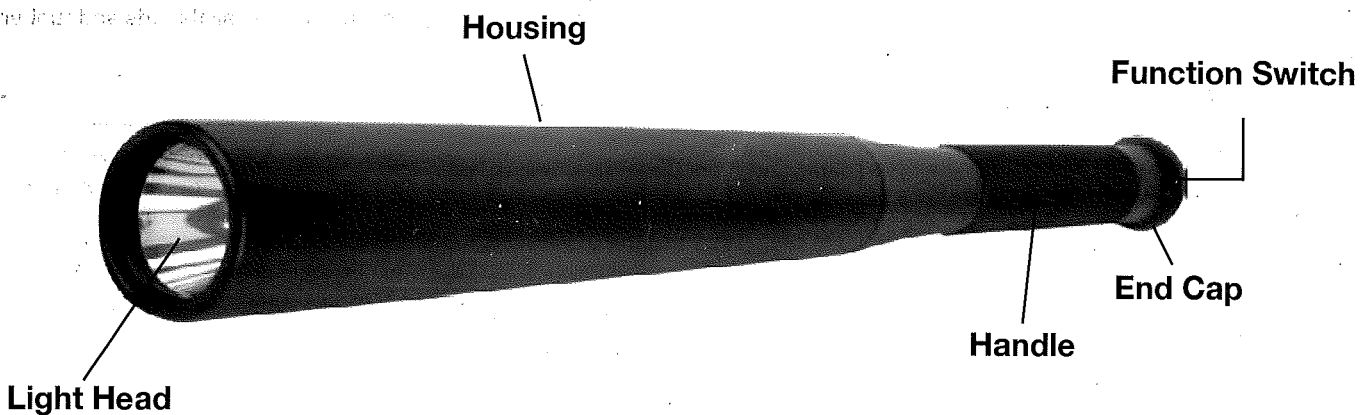
Any battery may leak harmful chemicals which may damage skin, clothing, or the inside of the tactical bat light. To avoid risk of injury, do not let any material leaked from a battery come in contact with eyes or skin. Any battery may rupture or explode if put in a fire or otherwise exposed to excessive heat.

To avoid risk of injury, do not expose batteries to excessive heat. To reduce the risk of personal injury or harm to your tactical bat light, take the following precautions:

- Follow battery manufacturer's instructions as to proper handling, storage and disposal of batteries.
- Use only alkaline batteries from a reputable manufacturer.
- Do not use different brands of batteries in the same tactical bat light.
- When replacing batteries, always replace the whole set.
- Do not use rechargeable or reusable alkaline batteries.

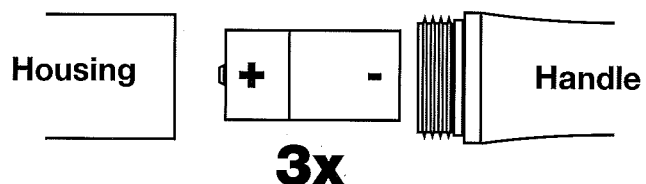
- Do not try to recharge batteries that are not specifically designed to be recharged.
- Always install batteries with the "+" end facing the front of the light and the "-" end facing the end of the light.
- Do not allow children to install batteries unsupervised.
- Follow battery manufacturer's instructions as to proper handling, storage and disposal of batteries.
- Carefully follow the steps listed under inspection and maintenance.
- Not recommended for use by children under seven years of age.
- Do not disassemble the light without supervision of professional technician.
- Take out of batteries when it is not in use.
- Do not look directly into the light. It could blind or hurt eyes.
- Keep out of reach of children.

BATTERY INSTALLATION

1. Twist the handle counter clockwise to unscrew from body.
2. Load 3 C batteries (not included) as shown right.
3. Twist the handle clockwise into body and tighten.

OPERATION

To cycle through the three functions of the tactical light do the following:

1. Press the function switch once for high beam
2. Press the function switch again for off

3. Press the function switch again for low beam
4. Press the function switch again for off
5. Press the function switch again for strobe

TROUBLESHOOTING

Tactical bat light failure

1. Check the light head for damage.
2. Check to make sure the batteries are installed correctly.
3. Check to make sure there are no loose connections between the light head, housing, handle or end cap.
4. Inspect the inside of the housing for corrosion.

5. If any corrosion is found it should be carefully cleaned. Wear protective gloves and ANSI approved eye wear during cleaning.

If all of the above steps have been followed and the tactical bat light still does not perform properly, call Customer Service toll free at 1-800-837-5994.

INSPECTION AND MAINTENANCE

Inspection

To get maximum life and performance from you Tactical Bat Light its recommended that you inspect and perform preventative maintenance on your tactical bat light regularly as follows:

Inspection Any battery may leak caustic solutions or gases which can corrode the inside of your tactical bat light. You should remove the batteries at least once a month and visually inspect the inside of the tactical bat light for signs of corrosion.

Separate Storage of Batteries

If your tactical bat light is used infrequently, e.g., once a month or less, it is recommended to remove the batteries and store them separately. This helps guard against corrosion and may also prolong battery life.

Routine Maintenance

Place a small amount of petroleum jelly on all threads and rubber O-rings every six months.
