



How to install parking curbs?



- I. Drill holes into the asphalt through the holes already in the rubber parking curb. Make sure the holes are at least $\frac{1}{2}$ inch wide and 3-4 inches deep.



- II. Drive the $\frac{1}{2}$ inch rebar spike through the holes in the rubber parking curb. Rebar Spikes should be 14 inches long.
- III. Leave the rubber parking curb undisturbed for a minimum of 12 hours. Rubber parking curbs do not require maintenance; however, it is advised to periodically check the spikes to see if they have come up. If they have, make sure to keep them hammered down below the surface of the parking curb.
