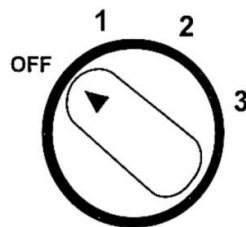

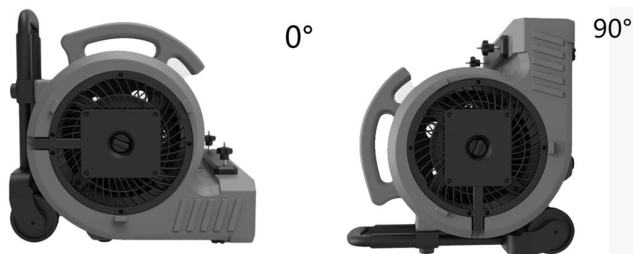

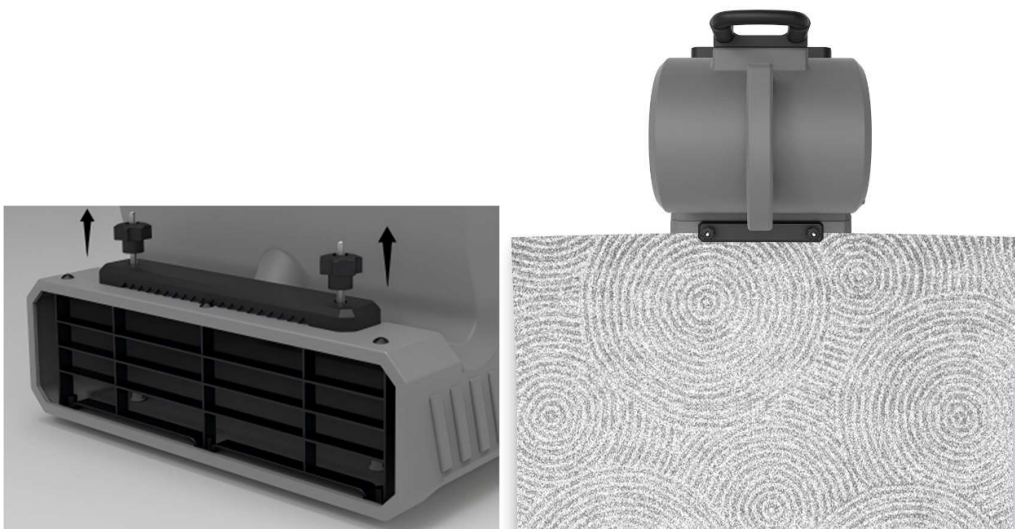
- Turn to "OFF" position to switch the air mover OFF. Turn to any speed position to switch the air mover ON.
- Turn clockwise to set the desired speed. 1-Low speed setting; 2-Med speed setting; 3-High speed setting

Multiple Operating Positions & Drying Arrangements

The air mover can operate at various positions, directing the airflow to desired areas.

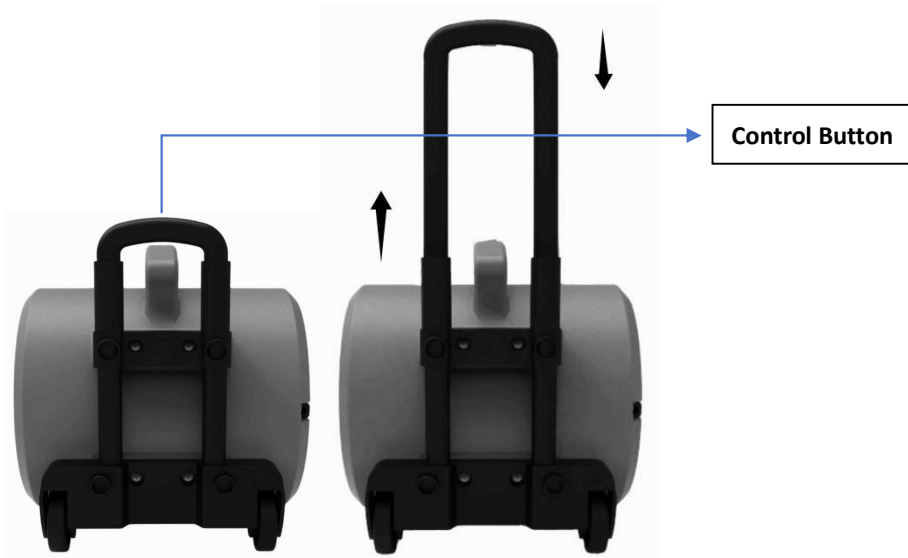


Carpet Clamp



Rotate the locknut and raise the clamp. Place the wet fabric above the air outlet, tighten up the locknut and ensure the wet fabric be clamped by plate. Strong airflow able to bring the moisture and dry the fabric.

Telescoping Handle

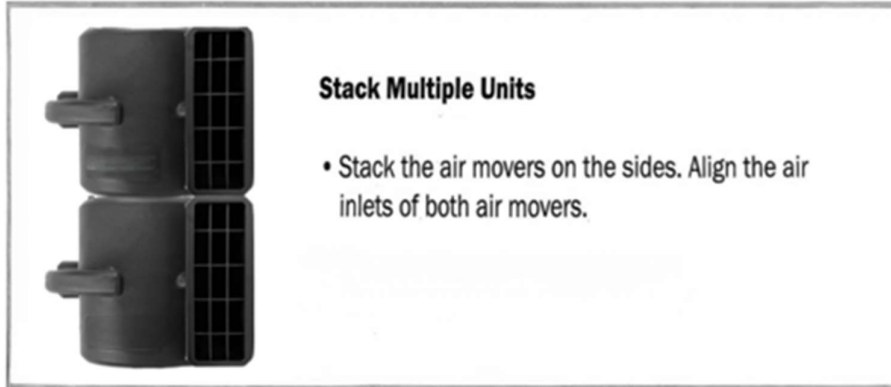


Easy movement- Press the button on the handle and pull out the telescoping pole to the longest position.

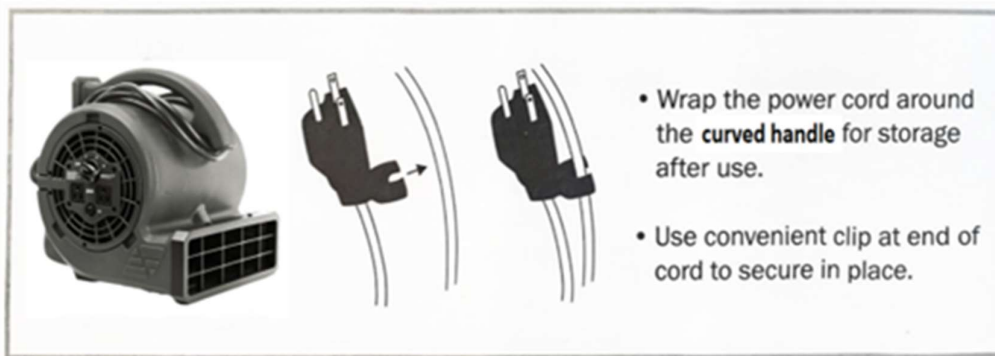
Save space storage- Press the button on the handle and push down the telescoping pole to the original position.

User Maintenance Instructions

Proper maintenance is recommended on this appliance. Failure to follow the maintenance instructions may cause failure of the appliance and void the warranty.

- When not in use, unplug and store the appliance in a dry and cool indoor place. Make sure it is out of reach for children.
- Before performing any maintenance or cleaning, always disconnect the air mover from its power source.
- Use damp cloth to wipe the surface of the housing. Do not clean the unit with water directly.
- Check if the grille covers are clean. Remove dirt or any other objects that could block the air inlet or air outlet.

Warranty Policy

Northern Tool and Equipment Company, Inc. ("We" or "Us") warrants to the original purchaser only ("You" or "Your") that the Ironon product purchased will be free from material defects in both materials and workmanship, normal wear and tear excepted, for a period of **one year** from date of purchase. The foregoing warranty is valid only if the installation and use of the product is strictly in accordance with product instructions. There are no other warranties, express or

implied, including the warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. If the product does not comply with this limited warranty, Your sole and exclusive remedy is that We will, at our sole option and within a commercially reasonable time, either replace the product or product component without charge to You or refund the purchase price (less shipping). This limited warranty is not transferable.

Limitations on the Warranty
